

Land Use Permit: Agricultural Buildings Acknowledgement

In accordance with MN Statutes Chapter 326B.103 agricultural buildings are defined as “a structure on agricultural land as defined by section 273.13, subdivision 23, designed, constructed, and used to house farm implements, livestock, or agricultural produce or products used by the owner, lessee, and sub lessee of the building and members of their immediate families, their employees, and persons engaged in the pickup or delivery of agricultural produce or products”.

I understand that the State Building Code requires compliance/inspection with the building code for non-agricultural buildings. I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand the State Building Code definition for an agricultural building and that my proposed building meets the definition.
