



## DEMOLITION DEBRIS

“Demolition Debris” means solid waste resulting from the demolition of buildings, road and other manmade structures including concrete, brick, bituminous concrete, untreated wood, masonry, glass, trees, rock, and non-plastic building parts. Demolition debris does not include asbestos waste.

### Acceptable Wastes:

Asphalt	Bituminous Concrete
Bricks	Concrete (Includes Re-rod)
Fencing	Masonry
Tree Stumps, Grubbing, Root Balls	Wood Pallets (Untreated)
Built-in Cabinetry	Ceramic Fixtures
Conduit	Glass
Insulation (fiberglass, cellulose, etc.)	Metal
Plastic	Roofing, Shingles
Tile (ceramic, floor, vinyl, etc.)	Wiring
Wood	

**\*\*Note\*\***      Mixed loads cannot be separated at the landfill.  
 Mixed loads will be charged the MSW rates.
